Terms of Competition

1- CONDITIONS

- a) The Championship is to be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as approved by the R & A Rules Limited, the Local Rules and Terms of Competition (Portuguese Golf Federation – Hard Card) and the Local Rules as approved by the Championship Committee;
- b) The Tournament counts for the WAGR.

2- ELIGIBILITY

- a) An entry will be accepted from any player with:
 - i. An exact handicap of 9,0 or better for Men and 16,1 or better for Ladies, certified at the date of the entry will be used for all purposes;
 - ii. 30 years old or over on 31st of December 2020 of the Championship;
 - iii. The starting field will comprise 100 competitors; 70 Men and 30 Ladies
 - iv. The starting field will comprise entrants in order of handicap;
 - v. Ten players nominated by the P.G.F. at its own discretion.

3- ENTRIES

- a) Entries must be received on the official Entry Form only.
- b) Entrants must confirm in all respects to the Rules of Amateur Status and shall sign the declaration to that effect contained in the Entry Form.
- c) Entries shall be made online in the Portuguese Golf Federation official website using the appropriate online entry form. Entries made after 1 p.m. (Local Time) on the **18th of October 2020** will not be accepted.
- d) Entries will be considered officially received after posted on the P.G.F. website– www.fpg.pt.
- e) All entries shall be subject to the approval of the Championship Committee which reserves the right to accept or refuse any entry without giving reason for its decision, which shall be final.

4- FORMAT

- a) The Championship shall be decided over 3 rounds of Stroke Play, 18 holes each day;
- b) In case of a tie for the first place after three rounds, the winner shall be decided by a sudden death play-off.
In case of a tie for the runner-up, shall be decided by the last 36, 18, 9, 6, 3 and last hole;
- c) The play-off shall start as soon as practicable after the last competitors have finished their final round.
- d) The Championship is to be played from the Yellow Tees (Men) and Red Tees (Ladies).



5- NATIONS CUP

- a) This Cup will be played simultaneously by National Teams.
- b) National Teams are composed by a minimum of two players and a maximum of three players.
- c) Each country may register as many teams as they wish.
- d) The result of the team will be obtained by the sum of the two lowest scores of each day.
- e) In the event of a tie, the total score of the third player will determine the winning team. If a tie persists, the two lowest scores of each team on the last 18 holes will be considered. If necessary, the team with the lowest individual score will be proclaimed winner and finally, by ballot.

6- PRIZES

The Champion and the runner-up will receive a Trophy provided by the P.G.F.
